Lecture #1:

Before the Flood, Noah, and Babel.

What can we know about the time before the Flood? Does Noah's ark still exist? Memories of the Flood outside the pages of the Bible. What did the tower of Babel look like? How did it affect the world?



Lecture #2:

Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

From Ur and Haran to Sodom and Gomorrah. Strange customs in Genesis explained by discoveries at Nuzi and Ebla. Abraham's worship of God. What are standing stones? Why did God reject them?

Lecture #3:

Joseph, Moses and the Exodus

Who were the Midianites? What is the evidence for the route of the Exodus? Is there any truth to recent claims that Mt. Sinai is in Saudi Arabia? How can discoveries in the tomb of King Tut help us understand the Tabernacle?



Lecture #4:

Joshua and the Judges.

Evidence for the destruction of Jericho and Hazor. Who were the Canaanites (Ugarit)? Evidence of the Israelites: their homes and way of life. Why do Samson and Goliath sound like Greek heroes?

Lecture #5:

David, Solomon, and the Kings.

New discoveries in David's Jerusalem. What remains of the Temple of Solomon? Is the Ark of the Covenant in Ethiopia? Discoveries at Dan and Arad. Evidence of religious compromise with false gods. Hezekiah's victory. The fall of Jerusalem to the Babylonians.
